Gateway Human Trafficking (GHT)'s Overview of Projects

Gateway Human Trafficking (GHT) is committed to educating our community and inspiring positive systemic change to end human trafficking.

Human trafficking is one of the most brutal heinous crimes which a human being could do to another human being. Many victims of human trafficking are students in our school system, and we want to help ensure our schools can and should be a safe haven for all children. Consequently, Gateway Human Trafficking (GHT) was established to educate and inform our community about human trafficking and child exploitation. Our goal is to empower our communities through education on how to identify- and report- human trafficking to minimize victimization of vulnerable people including children.

These are just a few ways that GHT works to help: Organizing conferences and Professional Development for different groups including law-enforcement agencies, social workers, business leaders, and faith communities; Providing speakers; Partnering with other like-minded organizations and individuals to design and execute our projects; And most importantly, educating K-12 Educators and youth groups about human trafficking, its risk factors, and how to report it to the proper authorities to save victims' lives.

GHT has already reached over **40,000** community members in the Greater St. Louis area.

GHT's programs

GHT believes a transformation toward a systemic change at individual, institutional, and societal level is needed to more effectively combat human trafficking and child exploitation.

Through its projects, GHT aims to inspire positive systemic change in St. Louis and St. Charles, MO, to prevent human trafficking and child exploitation before it occurs so that our children and families can thrive; and education is the key.

Yellow Butterfly Project (YBP) : Developing and coordinating educational models to raise awareness, education, and engagement regarding human trafficking. Making Invisible Visible (MIV) Project : Producing a series of anti- human trafficking short videos by GHT to raise awareness about human trafficking and child exploitation for our community members. For more information visit our website: www.gatewayhumantrafficking.org

Speaking Series Project : Providing on-going FREE presentations for civic groups, community base organizations, other non-profits, and college campuses (at local, national, and international levels) addressing various forms of trafficking in person and vulnerability of victims to educate the public, professionals, and service providers about human trafficking and child exploitation.

Partnership Project : Partnering with like-minded organizations, institutions, agencies, and social justice groups to enhance the community's understanding of human trafficking and child exploitation by organizing events and conferences.

Global Advocacy Project : Advocating for the global efforts to combat human trafficking and child exploitation by supporting the State Department Office to Monitor and Combat Trafficking in Persons (TIP Office) and its strategies of Prevention, Prosecution, Protection, and Partnership to combat human trafficking through organizing local events for international anti-human trafficking leaders and supporting the diplomatic humanitarian projects of the department.
